## Definitions of fees:

- ★ Badge fee: Each member organization has a badge/pin. Some organizations require a member to purchase a badge and others include it in the initiation fee. Badges may be very simple or jeweled. This is an out of pocket cost.
- ★ Chapter dues: These monies fund member activities including programming, recruitment, chapter supplies and chapter operations.
- ★ New member fee: Fee paid to establish membership in the organization.
- ★ New member corporation fee: One-time payment paid in new member semester to provide for the future housing needs of the chapter — primarily for updating the current housing facility in the future.
- ★ Panhellenic dues: These funds are used to support Panhellenic operations. Examples of items that may be included in the Panhellenic budget are attending conferences, ope operations, marketing and electronic media.
- ★ Empty Bed fee: the total cost per semester that a member would pay towards all empty beds in the house
- ★ National fee: Fee paid to inter/national organizations per member to support overall sorority operations.
