**The dues for initiated chapter members not living in the house are subject to change based on whether there is more than one empty room in the Kappa Delta house in the fall of 2025. One empty room is paid for by member dues but the rest of the cost is split amongst all initiated chapter members. Any initiated members living in the house will not have to pay the empty room fee or the common area maintenance fee. New members will not have to pay the empty room fee during their new member semester. Initiated members who are not living in the house were responsible for covering the cost of one empty room for the Fall of 2025. This came to be \$74 per member. The spring empty room cost will be determined by house occupancy come fall semester.

Definitions of fees:

- ★ National/Local New Member Fee: A one-time administrative fee for the new member process due within one week of First Degree.
- ★ National/Local Initiation Fee: A one-time fee that includes a certificate of membership, a lifetime alumnae membership, and a lifetime subscription to the Angelos. This fee is due in full before Initiation.
- ★ Minimum Badge Fee: A one-time fee to purchase the standard badge. If you would like to purchase a more ornate badge, the cost ranges from \$126 to \$596. You will order your badge through the New Member Portal before initiation.
- ★ Facility Fee: A one-time fee that contributes to a long-term savings account for future housing projects or needs.
- ★ Common Area Maintenance Fee: A fee paid to cover the ongoing costs to operate and maintain the facility and furnishings.
- ★ National Dues: A biannual fee paid to support the national organization.
- ★ KDF: Children in Need/Golden Circle: Contributions to support the educational, leadership, and philanthropic initiatives of the Kappa Delta Foundation.
- ★ New/Initiated Member Chapter Dues: A fee paid by each new or initiated member for general chapter use and events.
- ★ Local Panhellenic Dues: A fee paid to fund local Panhellenic activities.
- ★ Formal/Informal Income: A fee paid to cover the cost of the chapter's social activities.
- ★ T-shirt Income: A fee paid to cover the cost of chapter-wide t-shirts.

Additional costs:

- ★ Our dues are all-inclusive. You will not be required to pay for anything that is not outlined in this document. Payment plans are available if needed.
