Definitions of fees:

- ★ Badge fee: Each member organization has a badge/pin. Badges may be very simple or jeweled. When a member is purchasing her badge, they determine how much or little they would like to spend.
- ★ Chapter dues: These monies fund member activities including programming, recruitment, chapter supplies and chapter operations.
- ★ New member fee: Fee paid to establish membership in the organization.

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- ★ Panhellenic dues: These funds are used to support Panhellenic operations. Examples of items that may be included in the Panhellenic budget are attending conferences, office operations, marketing and electronic media.
- ★ Building and Furnishing Fund: The entire membership has access to the house and thus the property is subject to a great deal of wear and tear. This fee is used primarily for care and maintenance of the property and furnishings in the common areas of the chapter facility.
- ★ Empty Bed fee: the total cost per semester that a member would pay towards all empty beds in the house.
- ★ NHC Administration fee: Fee paid to inter/national organization per member to support overall sorority operations.

Additional costs (Not required for the first semester in chapter):

- ★ Philanthropy shirts: Our chapter holds a philanthropy event each semester in which we sell t-shirts to commemorate the event and raise money for our philanthropy partners. Chapter members are required to purchase these shirts to be worn at the event.
- ★ Philanthropy money: Our chapter members are required to donate a certain amount of philanthropy money each semester. This includes donating to other Greek organizations' philanthropy events, fundraising events on campus, or any cause supported by the member.
- ★ Amount required to raise for philanthropy events: Each chapter member is required to raise a certain amount for our philanthropy events to go towards our national and local philanthropy partners. We typically use a share the wealth system, meaning that if one sister raises more money than required, the total raised over the goal will go towards helping other members in the chapter to reach their goal as well.
